## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these terms and conditions. Any entry not complying with these terms and conditions is invalid. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.
- 2. Entry is open to Australian residents, with no limit on the number of entries per person Directors, management and employees and their immediate families of the promoter and agencies associated with the promotion are ineligible to enter. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (including adopted children), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step- sister or first cousin.

- 6. Entries are deemed to be received at the time they are received by the promoter's database and not at the time of submission by the entrant. The promoter does not accept responsibility and is not liable for late, lost, incomplete, incorrectly submitted, delayed, illegible, corrupted or misdirected entries, claims or correspondence due to error, omission, tampering, deletion, theft, communications failure or otherwise. The promoter has no control over communications networks and is not liable for any problems associated with them due to traffic congestion, technical malfunction or otherwise. The promoter is not liable for any consequences of user error including (without limitation) costs incurred. Entrants who enter using multiple aliases may be disqualified.

- 12. If the promoter forms the view in its sole discretion that an entry or the entry process for any entrant has been tampered with or otherwise does not comply with these terms and conditions, the promoter reserves the right to disqualify that entry. Any attempt, deliberate or otherwise, to cause malicious damage or interference with the normal functioning of the competition website or the information on the competition website, or to otherwise undermine the legitimate operation of this competition may be a violation of criminal and civil laws and, should such an attempt be made, whether successful or not, the promoter reserves the right to seek damages to the fullest extent permitted by law. If the promoter suffers loss or incurs any costs in connection with any breach of these terms and conditions or any other legal obligation by an entrant, the entrant agrees to indemnify the promoter for those losses, damages and costs.

If the documentation required by the promoter is not received by the promoter (or a person nominated by the promoter) or an entrant or entry has not been verified or validated to the promoter's satisfaction then all the entries of that entrant will be ineligible and deemed invalid.

Certain legislation may imply warranties or conditions or impose other obligations including statutory consumer guarantees which cannot be excluded, restricted or modified except to a limited extent. To the extent permitted by law, the promoter excludes all guarantees, warranties, conditions or other terms that apply under or are implied by statute, common law or trade custom or usage.
